





NOVA FCSH ensures a free shuttle service between the two spaces. Each trip is direct and takes approximately 10 minutes.

The starting point at Av. de Berna will be the CARRIS/TST stop in front of the main entrance.The stop at Colégio Almada Negreiros will be at the entrance via Rua da Mesquita.

Any member of the community can use this vehicle, marked as belonging to NOVA FCSH. To prove it, students must display their student card. Teachers, researchers or employees can use their business card or request a statement from the Faculty to access the shuttle.




3RD FLOOR




2ND FLOOR



INTERNET ACCESS ON CAMPUS

Wireless network

NOVA FCSH's Wi-Fi antenna park covers the campus. Libraries, auditoriums, computer rooms, classrooms, patio-terrace, bars and canteen have wi-fi coverage.

Access is made exclusively through the network eduroam, which is accessed with the FCSH ID credentials.

With these same FCSH credentials you can also access the internet at all Portuguese and European universities, since eduroam is the wireless network of European universities.

<u>Our page</u> allows you to follow all the steps to eduroam configuration for various operative systems.

NOVA FCSH's IT Services are available to provide technical support and answer questions that may arise.

Cable

In NOVA FCSH's study rooms there are network sockets to connect laptops. For this, you must use a UTP network cable and introduce the following data in the manual configuration of the browser network proxy:

Proxy: proxy.fcsh.unl.pt Port: 3128

- In Internet Explorer, these fields are in:
 Tools > Internet Options > Links > LAN settings
- In Firefox, these fields are in:Tools > Options > Advanced > Network > Settings
- On Mac OS, this data is part of the Control panel network.

NOVA FCSH's internal network allows, from the outset, Internet access only via HTTP protocols and HTTPS (web pages).

Accessing external locations through other protocols (such as POP or FTP) is assigned upon request, to be made to the Helpdesk service of the Computer Core.
