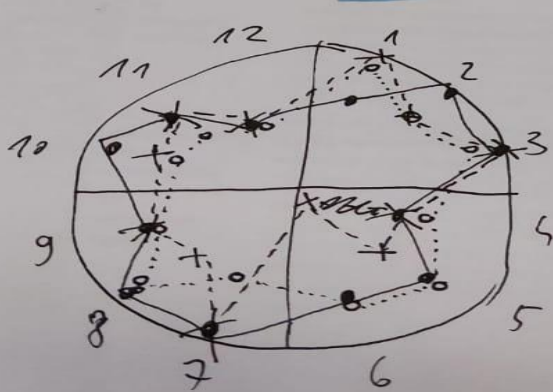

He has held various positions, such as Head of the Planning Department, Deputy Manager of Urban Planning, Deputy Director of Public Management and Deputy Director of Information and Participation, in the Singular Projects unit.

In recent years he has worked as senior advisor for the General Direction of Strategic Planning in participation tasks and representing Madrid in city networks such as C40 or Metropolis.

Retired as an civil servant of the Madrid City Council in 2021, he continues as a senior advisor in tasks of communication, giving lectures on urban projects in Madrid at local and foreign universities, as well as receiving delegations from around the world for guided tours of these projects.
